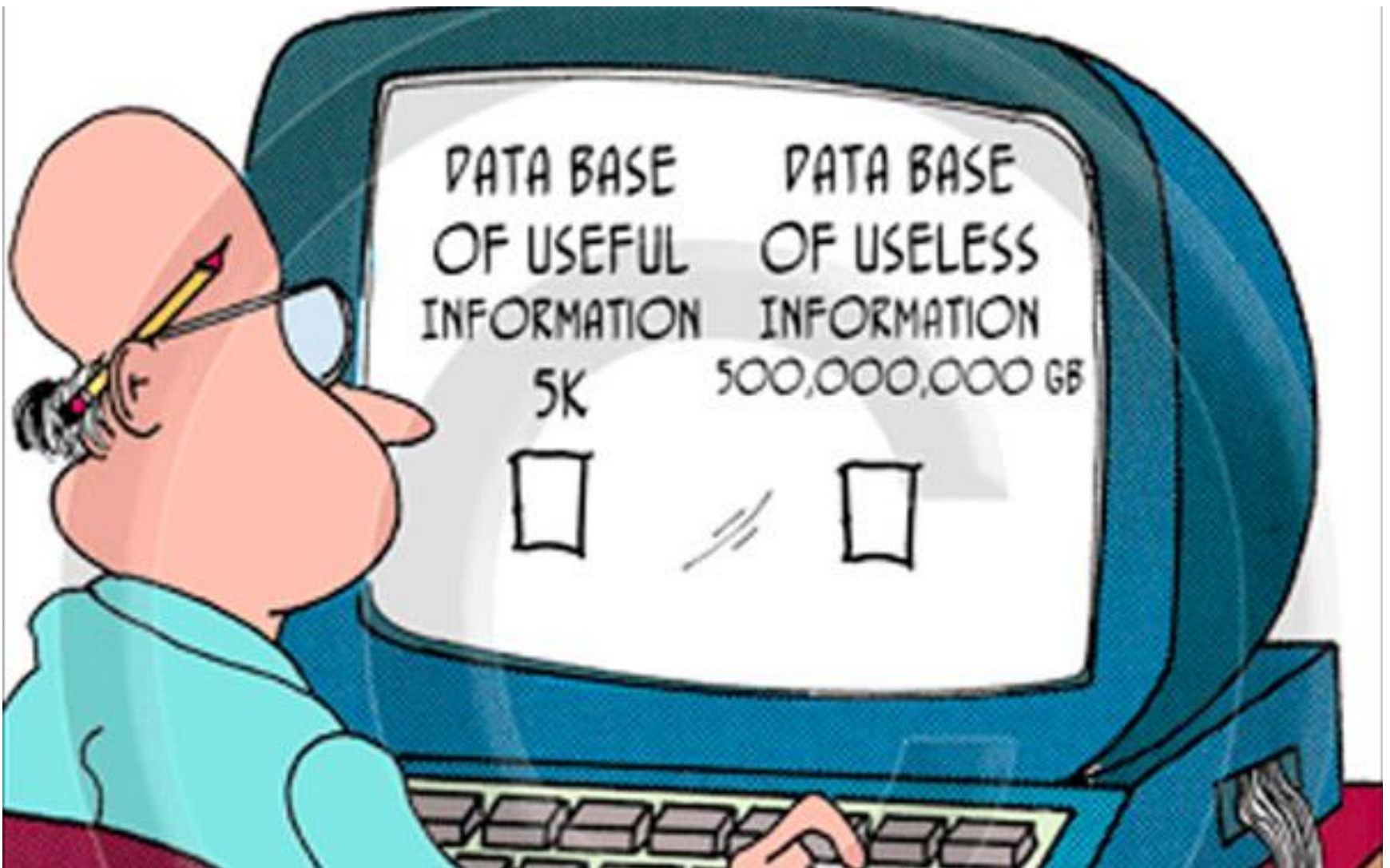

- Common Agenda
 - Have data at the table
- Common Progress Measures
 - Balance clarity and precision

Collective Impact Limitations: Own Them

- Participatory
 - Identify affected populations
- Equity
 - Disaggregated data
- Policy or Systems Change
 - Audience specific data



Data Tips

Do's

- Lead with values
- Frame the story, use social math
- Explain causal factors
- Show that solutions exist

Don'ts

- Put the numbers first
- Leave open or uninterpreted
- Only describe problem
- Evoke crisis

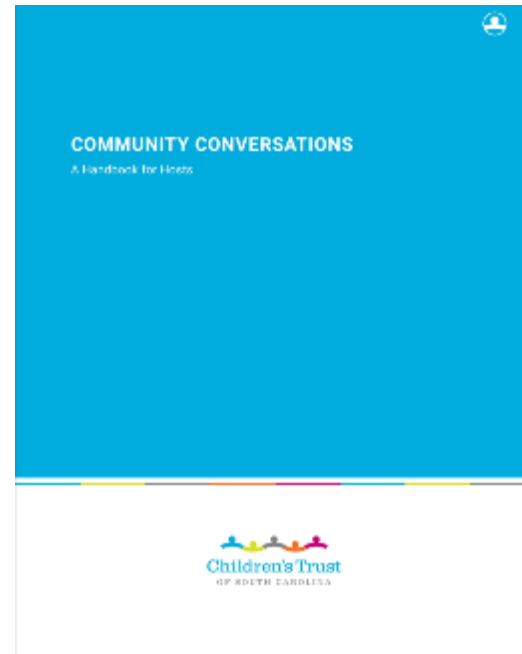
